

## Magda Herzberger, Author and Holocaust Survivor

Magda Herzberger was born and raised in the city of Cluj, Romania. She and her family were deported to the German concentration camps in 1944 when the Nazi's occupied her native city. She is a survivor of three death camps: Auschwitz, Bremen, and Bergen Belsen. Most of her family members were killed by the Nazis. Magda is a poet, lecturer and composer. She is also the author of four previously published books: "The Waltz of the Shadows" (an autobiography in poetry form), "Eyewitness to Holocaust" (an autobiographical essay consisting of prose and poetry), "Will You Still Love Me?" (a collection of love poems dedicated to her husband), and "Songs of

Life" (a poetry book). Magda will be doing a book signing of her latest book, "Survival," which recounts her ordeal in the concentration camps. The book will be available for purchase at the event.
